Dear Applicant:

Welcome to the 2016, Department of Michigan, Marine Corps League Scholarship information letter.

Please be sure to read the Scholarship Purpose, Eligibility and Requirements for 2016. It is your responsibility to make sure that all phases of the application are completed and signed and that the Sponsorship Section is completed and signed with the proper Detachment / Unit Identification and address enclosed. All scholarship applications are due by May 8, 2016. Any postmarked after this date will not be considered.

Incomplete applications will not be considered and will not be returned.

If you are granted a scholarship, you will be notified by mail before June 30th. At this time, you will be required to send proof of enrollment for 2015 - 2016 to the Scholarship Chairman by September 30th. If all of your paperwork is in order, your name will be submitted to the Department Paymaster to issue a check in your favor. The disbursement of awards will be issued by the Department prior to November 10th.

Be sure to use the address on your application that you want your check mailed to if awarded a scholarship. It is your responsibility to notify the scholarship chairman of any change of address.

On behalf of the Department of Michigan, Marine Corps League, Marine Corps League Auxiliary and the Scholarship Committee, we wish you all the best of luck in your educational pursuits.

1 small pkg. orange Gelatin 11 oz. Can mandarin Oranges

1 (8oz) whipped topping 1 sm. Pkg. cottage cheese

Stir dry gelatin into whipped topping. Add Cottage Cheese, Mix, thoroughly. Carefully mix in oranges saving a few for garnish. Let set in refrigerator for 2 hours. Any flavor of Jell-O can be used with the coordinating fruit. Great light desert esp. around Easter!
